Bennelong Australian Equity Partners (BAEP) was established in July 2008 as a joint venture between Bennelong Funds Management and Paul Cuddy and Mark East, two investment professionals with a wealth of experience in the Australian funds management industry. Paul and Mark direct our Australian equities capabilities with the support of Bennelong Funds Management, which provides all non-investment related services including compliance, product, marketing and distribution support.

BAEP manage three Australian equities funds which, although not limited to, primarily select stocks from the S&P/ASX 300 Index. The funds include:

- the **Bennelong Australian Equities Fund**, which typically holds approximately 35 stocks;
- the **Bennelong Concentrated Australian Equities Fund**, which typically holds approximately 25 stocks; and
- the **Bennelong ex-20 Australian Equities Fund**, which typically holds approximately 30 stocks, excluding those from the S&P/ASX 20 Leaders Index.

### Investment philosophy

The team believes equity markets are naturally imperfect, whereby behavioural biases often lead to securities being mispriced. Stock prices ultimately represent a trade-off between valuation and earnings growth, so it follows that stock prices are driven by the quality and magnitude of earnings growth.

As a result of their philosophical beliefs, BAEP's objective is to identify and invest in quality companies that exhibit mispriced earnings growth.

### Investment process

BAEP's investment process identifies quality companies run by strong management teams that deliver underappreciated earnings growth and superior capital return efficiencies mispriced by the market.

Rigorous fundamental bottom-up analysis coupled with insightful proprietary quantitative research supports our approach. In addition, the co-head operating structure delivers a robust portfolio 'co-pilot' proposition which constantly challenges the consistency of the portfolio versus the process signals.

### Investment style

BAEP's investment style can be described as 'core' with an aversion to earnings risk and a bias towards the following attributes:

- strong franchises run by quality management;
- strong and reliable earnings growth;
- strong/improving capital return efficiencies; and
- stocks which are under-appreciated by the market.
